Where?	School Field, Wray.
Price?	£5 per boot
Do I need to pre-book?	No, just turn up on the day. Gates open from 8.00am. Try not to arrive early as the field is surrounded by local residents.
How much space can I have?	No particular restrictions. There is plenty of space on the field.
Are vans permitted?	Yes
Are traders welcome?	Yes, if selling second hand goods only.
Do you need caterers?	No thanks. Catering provided in the village throughout the Scarecrow Festival.
How long can we stay?	We would hope that stall holders would stay until the afternoon to benefit from the likely visitor numbers coming to see the Scarecrows.
Where is the School Field?	Behind Main Street but accessed from the B6480 Wennington Road and Home Farm Close. Vehicular access will be signed on the day. Visitors should use the signed Scarecrow Festival car parks which also be signed on the day.
Are there toilet facilities?	Yes, adjacent to the School Field.
Are refreshments available?	Yes. At the Village Institute from about 9:30 or 10:00
Can I donate goods for sale?	Yes. A stall will be established selling donated goods with all funds raised going to support the Village Institute. Please deliver unwanted and surplus items to the Village Institute (Snooker Room) anytime between Monday 18 th April and Friday 22 nd April. If you need goods to be collected please call Ernie on 07800 647481. Please ensure that the goods are in a saleable condition as we have no facilities for disposing of unsold items. No large furniture or electrical items please.
