River and Flood Management Film Evening for farmers and land managers. Tuesday 13th February at 7pm in Wray Institute.

Everyone who has land that floods, or may contribute to flooding downstream is invited to this film evening.

We will show High Water - Common Ground (65mins). This is a film showing projects in Britain where successful flood management has been installed with the help of local farmers and landowners. This will be followed by Remembering and Restoring the River Roeburn (28mins) which explores how Wray flood affected the river and how we might start to restore it to a more steady flow. These films and the following discussion will help land managers explore and understand how they might get Countryside Stewardship grants (9th March deadline to get application form for 2018), or other grants to carry out this work and reduce the flood risk for all other landowners downstream and Wray, Hornby and Lancaster.
