### **Wray with Botton Neighbourhood Plan Referendum 30<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

It's taken almost five years, but we've finally done it!

Thanks to everyone who has helped produce a Neighbourhood Plan for Wray, we now have a plan wholeheartedly supported by the Village. It will now be approved ("made") by the City Council, when it will become the prime document to be used in considering future planning applications in the Village.

In the Referendum Parishioners were asked the following question: "Do you want Lancaster City Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Wray-with-Botton to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"
