**Would you like to help the Lune Rivers Trust** reduce erosion and potential flood risk in Roeburndale? Volunteers are invited to help with the work that will help slow, spread and sink flood water before it damages the Roeburn river banks. We aim to meet once a fortnight on Saturday, or Tuesday 10.30am – 4.00pm to work together and learn how to build leaky woody dams in Roeburndale Woods, plant trees and hedges on the contour, make small check dams, survey land and other activities. First event - Roeburndale Woods, Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> October.

This is part of a Water Environment Grant from the Environment Agency and Natural England. The long term aim is to slow the river flow in Roeburndale and to combat acute erosion in Roeburndale Woods SSSI and help maintain the Good Ecological Status of the River Roeburn by controlling the input of silt and sediment. Overall this will help reduce flooding in Wray, Hornby, Caton and Lancaster.

This is an exciting project working with farmers in Roeburndale and learning some skills we will need to combat flooding in the future.
