**WRAY SCARECROW FESTIVAL 2010**  
**Important information for residents of Main Street**

As the festival in our village continues to grow, so does the need for safety measures. Following the last two years events and the traffic and pedestrian volumes involved, the police have requested that a temporary road closure be instigated for Main street for the peak times of **10.00 to 16.00 on 1st, 2nd and 3rd May.**

This road closure will be through Lancaster City Council and under the provisions of sec.21 of Town police clauses act 1847 which allows for temporary closures for events such as ours. It applies to vehicular traffic only and will be from the junction with Wennington road to the Tea Rooms. A diversion route will be signed for vehicles wishing to pass through the village that will take them along Agnes Ing Lane.

The signs will be erected at 10.00 a.m. each day and removed at 4.00 p.m. The 'barrier' at Wennington road will be staffed continually.

Please be reassured that access remains open for all residents on Main street to park and get their vehicle out during the closure. Pedestrians are not affected.

*If you need to move through the closure for access:*

- \* Be aware that pedestrians may not know you are approaching - they will think the road is totally free of vehicles.
- \* Please move very slowly - 10 mph max.

- \* Put your hazard lights on.
- \* **Think children**
- \* Use the diversion route or go via Butt Yeats and School Lane for the bottom of the village.

**1st Responders** needs lots more new recruits to keep the service running. Are you an able bodied person with access to a vehicle, who is willing and able to give some time to your community? Training in resuscitation techniques will be provided.

What does it entail:

1. You and your partner (wife, husband, close friend, etc.) agree to be on call for one day or one night however often is convenient.
2. During that time you stay within the call area together with the kit and carrying a bleeper. You are NOT confined to your home and if covering a night you can go to bed.
3. You answer the call as quickly as possible and help the patient until the ambulance arrives. They then take over. (Time taken approx. half an hour).
4. 1st Responders are not called out to gory accidents, only to possible heart attacks, strokes, choking, fainting etc., where immediate help can make a tremendous difference to a patients recovery.

We live in a healthy area so the number of callouts is very light, most likely only two or three a year if you are doing one shift a week.
