Fly Tipping in the area is on the increase. Fly tipping is the illegal disposal of waste without a waste management licence, it is a criminal offence, be it household or industrial and commercial. Incorrect disposal of 'controlled waste' is also an offence. Controlled waste includes: General household waste, larger domestic items such as fridges and mattresses, garden refuse, commercial waste such as builders' rubble, clinical waste and tyres.

If you see anyone dumping anything, please don't approach them, but take details of times, places, vehicles involved and report them either to Lancaster City Council 01524 582491 or The fly tipping hotline on 0800807060.

Under the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005 Fly Tipping is a criminal offence.

The maximum fine for fly tipping is £50,000 in a magistrates court and unlimited in the higher courts and up to five years imprisonment.
