By the time you read this there will be households on the Old Moor Rd route connected and receiving High Speed broadband. This has been a great achievement by the digging teams. We are grateful for the goodwill of the landowners. This route is connected to the cabinet in Wennington. Meanwhile the cabinet for the rest of the parish has been installed at Tatham Fells Old School and routes to it are being extended in many directions. Critical to this is the completed duct from Mealbank Bridge to Millhouses. Work to lay the ducting has to be carried out through much of the route between cuts of grass for silage but with the fine weather all should be completed by the Autumn.

Parishioners have been very generous linking loans & the purchase of shares to the Tatham routes. Please continue to do so. Wray Village Life - August 1914

Miss Alice Jane Kenyon died on the 24th August, ending her long connection with the Band of Hope and the Temperance Cause.

The War - Europe is now the scene of a most terrible war, and our country has been drawn into it. (The hope was for a brief struggle and victory for the cause). At a public meeting on August 17th it was decided to support the National Relief Fund. A special service was held on Sunday 30th in the school, seldom, if ever, had there been a larger congregation. The Vicar presided and the collection amounted to £18.0s.3d. with subsequent offerings increasing the amount to £23.10s.3d. The Vicar ended the service with an appeal for Belgium refugees, This raised £4.12s 6d.

A sum of £8 was gathered for soldiers' clothing and a ladies committee purchased 12 dozen pairs of socks, 12 dozen pairs of bootlaces and 12 dozen handkerchiefs.

Friday August 21st was observed as a Day of Intercession on behalf of HM Naval and Military Forces.

Mr. Lyon wrote on his way to Australia:

Weather - 16 days of rain with a depth of 2.60 inches.

He was on the RM Steamer Otway, and was disappointed at not being able to land at Gibraltar due to the war. Apparently, on its way to Malta, the ship displayed no lights, except those suggesting they were a tramp steamer, and, all signs of wireless apparatus was removed.
