Registrations

Registrations continue to progress well. As of Sunday 13th November we have 491 registrations in the initial area and over 150 registrations of interest from outside the immediate area. All good stuff!

Share Offering

In the last Newsletter we indicated that we had set the funding launch date as being mid November. To gain permission to undertake this share offering, as you would expect, requires prior approval from such overseeing bodies as Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC), the Financial Services Authority and others.
