Wray Scarecrow Festival 2011- Important information for residents of Main Street

Following the last few years events and the use of a road closure last year, the police have again requested that a temporary road closure be instigated for Main street for the peak times of **10.00 to 16.00 on Friday 29th April, Sat 30th April, Sun 1st May and Monday 2nd May.**

This road closure will be through Lancaster City Council and under the

provisions of sec.21 of Town police clauses act 1847 which allows for the temporary closure for events such as ours. It applies to vehicular traffic only and will be from the junction with Wennington road to the tea rooms. A diversion route will be signed for vehicles wishing to pass through the village that will take them along Agnes Ings Lane.

The signs will be erected at 10 am each day and removed at 4 pm. The 'barrier' at Wennington Road will be staffed continually as will the barrier at the tea rooms. Following some concerns from last year, extra information signage has been made that will assist in explaining the diversion route to visitors. This will minimise people using the diversion route that don't need to.

Please be reassured that access remains open for residents on Main Street to park and get their vehicle in and out during the closure. Pedestrians are not affected.

If you need to move through the closure for access:

- * Be aware that pedestrians may not know you are approaching - they will think the road is totally free of vehicles.
- * Please move very slowly - 10 mph maximum.
- * Put your hazard lights on.
- * ***Think children***
- * Use the diversion route or go via Butt Yeats and School Lane for the bottom of the village.
