## **B4RN in Tatham**

May has seen real progress in laying the ducting for superfast Broadband in Tatham. By the time you read this the Rubicon will have been crossed at Mealbank Bridge so that the all important connection will be complete between Wray & Wennington from which the spurs will lead into Tatham.

You may have seen the huge activity this month around Old Moor Road where the route is progressing fast thanks to the generosity and hard work of the residents. The pictures on the second Connect Tatham newsletter of this work make good viewing. At the other end of the parish work is in progress on Lyth Fell. As the first silage crops are taken the routes from Mealbank bridge up to Lowgill should be well under way. The cabinet, the hub of the network will be installed in the grounds of the Old School in June. Housing the Cabinet there will give free superfast broadband access to both the Church and the Old School. It does seem as if the hard digging work can be completed throughout the Parish by the Autumn. Please keep in touch with where work is taking place from the B4RN Connect Tatham website so you can help with laying the ducting in your area.

The management group are urgently needing further offers of mechanical diggers & drivers to carry out the work. As you know the work can be paid for through “digging” shares for the contractor or by parishioners making loans. Loans should specify for use in Tatham. The details can be found on
