A Reminder - what is the Neighbourhood Plan?

When produced and approved by the community in a Referendum, it forms part of the legal planning framework alongside national and local (Lancaster City) policies and will be used to assess future planning applications. It gives us a say in the future development of our area, ensuring that existing assets are protected and local needs are addressed.

Due to the demands of Wray Fair The Neighbourhood Planning Group has met on just one occasion, the 14th May 2015 since the last meeting on the 16th April 2015. During the intervening period the Opinion Survey has been completed, the group is currently awaiting feedback of the results, which is being undertaken independently and will be published as soon as possible thereafter. During Wray Fair members of the Sub-Group undertook a survey asking visitors their thoughts on Wray, its facilities (Post Office, Pub, Tea Rooms and Garden Centre) and whether any future large scale development would likely to affect their opinion of Wray. The results of this Survey will be included in the Opinion Survey.

The Sub-Group will be holding an **Open Day** on the 4th July 2015 in Wray Institute. Its purpose is to update all interested parties on our progress so far and to consult with interested parties on the issues moving forward with the development of the Neighbourhood Plan.
