My name is Joanne Postlethwaite. I live in Wray and I am one of your representatives on Wray Parish Council.

At the last meeting, the Parish Council was approached by a local parent about the poor state of the community playground, with a request to investigate the possibility of replacing it. The park is now 15 years old (the normal lifetime of park equipment) and looks very dated compared to the new equipment that is in our neighbouring parks, which have all been upgraded.

I have since started to investigate playground equipment companies and should be getting some quotes soon for removing and replacing the existing playground. I have only been able to give the companies a rough idea of what new equipment to supply, based on conversations I have had with some parents and grandparents in the village. I would like to invite all residents to provide me with some feedback on the kind of park equipment they think would be best for our community; I have left brochures from a few playground companies in the Institute computer room.

Please browse the brochures, take them home for a few days if you wish, and fill in the feedback sheets provided.
