The church held an Intercession Service on Sunday September 20th. Prayers were offered for the King, Soldiers and Sailors and for peace. The organist, Mr. Chadderton, concluded the proceedings by playing the National Anthems of the five allies, finishing with the Hallelujah Chorus. £5.2s.01/2d. was collected for war refugees.

Burial - September 17th - Thomas Robinson (aged 6 days)

Weather - 13 days of rain at a depth of 2.98 inches
