## **Wray Neighbourhood Plan**

### **A reminder - what is the Neighbourhood Plan?**

**When produced and approved by the community in a Referendum, it forms part of the legal planning framework alongside national and local (Lancaster City) policies and will be used to assess future planning applications. It gives us a say in the future development of our area, ensuring that existing assets are protected and local needs are addressed.**

Since the last meeting the Group has met on two occasions; 23rd July and 3rd August 2015. During those meetings our Vision and objectives were reviewed, no changes were made they will however remain an agenda item and be adjusted if necessary.

### **Meeting 9th July 2015**

A brief update on the Parish wide business surveys was given. So far there has been a 25% return rate, which has also led to some completed housing need responses being received.

Eddie Taylor (Neighbourhood Plan Consultant) was unable to attend this meeting therefore no update was available to the meeting regarding the Opinion and Housing Needs surveys.

Robert Partington, John Yellowley, Bob Smith and Eddie Taylor attended a meeting with Lancaster City Council. They discussed the progress of Wray's Neighbourhood Plan and were informed by Planning Officers that following a recent High Court ruling, until our plan is formally adopted as part of the legal planning framework, it could not be used to assess planning applications. However, we could use evidence gained from assessing sites to ensure that existing assets are protected.

Wray's Plan is currently ahead of the City Council's development management plan. There have been some recent changes in the ground rules from Government and the Council are reassessing their housing



needs. The Council's land allocation document is ongoing and will not be in place until after the July 2016 consultation.

The members of the Group discussed options available, which would enable us to move forward with assessing sites. Robert Partington is to circulate an assessment sheet to members of the Wray group, which has been prepared by the Council to assess sites within the Silverdale and Arnside AONB.

The group agreed that focussing on assessing the sites identified for potential development was of paramount importance. Other actions also needed to be undertaken as a matter of urgency; the AONB with regard to their development policy, the Lune Rivers Trust, Middlewood Trust, the Environment Agency and contacting someone with specific knowledge of birds and moths. In addition we need to interpret the information gathered from the housing needs survey.

It was agreed that our plan should be permissive of development whilst managing development effectively.

#### Meeting 6th August 2015

Eddie Taylor produced an interim report which reviewed existing evidence and summarised key measures, which will help us progress the Neighbourhood Plan. He talked through his report. He asked the meeting “what is the role of Wray” and how is it perceived by those who live and work there and those who visit.

The meeting discussed the format of the report and agreed that;

- \* Bob Smith's Heritage Report should be used as historic evidence
- \* That we need to look at the MAGIC website to see how land is used  
<http://magic.defra.gov.uk/>
- \* Set up a working party to look through the Silverdale/Arnside form to assess sites.
- \* A professional report needs to be produced on the uniqueness of Wray

- \* The traditions of the village should be identified and recorded
- \* The Group needs to produce housing figures reasonable for the area and agree them with Council
- \* We need to protect what villagers and visitors value.
